Friday, 14th of July

- 08.00 - 17.30 **Field trip:** The excursion will lead us to different localities in western Hungary visiting the newly discovered Late Cretaceous vertebrate site at Iharkút and the Pliocene alginite quarry at Pula with vertebrate bearing deposits. Costs: approx. **30 Euro** including lunch

Saturday, 15th of July

- 08.00 - 17.30 **Field trip:** The excursion will lead us to the famous Miocene track site and vertebrate locality, Ipolytarnóc. Costs: approx. **30 Euro** including sandwiches and drinks.

Presentations

Altogether 20 minutes are available for each speaker, including 5 minutes for questions and brief discussions. Those who have a poster presentation may mount their posters soon after arrival and registration.

Media Information

For Your presentation You may use:

- 35mm slides. Single slide projector.
- Overhead projector.
- Video-projector (PowerPoint presentations)
- Posters should not exceed 100 cm in width and 150 cm in height.

Abstracts

As mentioned already in the 1st circular, the deadline for abstracts is **1st May**. It has also been noted that besides “normal” abstracts there is a possibility to prepare extended abstracts (max. 6 A4 pages including text figures and references). All formats and font types are accepted.

Field trips

A slight modification (see underlined) takes place compared to the plans in the 1st circular. Two field trips will be held after the symposium on Friday and Saturday, 14th and 15th July. The first one on Friday (14th July) will be organized to the western part of Hungary and it takes a full day. In the first part of the day the recently discovered and documented Late Cretaceous vertebrate locality, **Iharkút** (160 km from Budapest) will be visited. After visiting the Iharkút site the nearby Pliocene **Pula** vertebrate locality will be visited instead of the Pannonian Polgárdi locality planned before.

Participants of the second field trip on Saturday (15th July) will have the opportunity to see and study the famous Miocene vertebrate locality of **Ipolytarnóc** (trackways of mammals and birds) in the northern part of Hungary (110 km from Budapest).

Conference dinner

The conference dinner (approx. **25 Euro**) will be on a pleasure boat at Wednesday evening together with a boat trip on the Danube.

Accommodation

Those who wish to sleep **at the place of the Conference (The Bolyai Elite College)** MUST indicate it to the Organizing Committee (see the separated sheet below). Their booking will be done by us. Attention!
